On or after the 1st September 2020, until the completion of the audit, the Auditor General for Wales will provide any local government elector of the area to which the accounts relate, give the elector, or his/her representative, an opportunity to question him about the accounts. Any such elector, or his/her representative, may attend before the Auditor General to make any objection to the accounts.
